### **Clyde Street Former Gasworks Remediation Project**

We are writing to inform you of the current status of the Clyde Street Remediation Project, which is taking place on the former gasworks site with frontage to Chatham Road and Clyde Street.

Environmental investigations have been underway since January this year to better understand the nature and extent of contamination at the site. These works also involved the installation of a groundwater boundary control system in order to prevent or minimise the offsite migration of contaminated groundwater until the Stage 2 main remediation works commence.

The project team is currently preparing two important documents:

- The Remediation Action Plan – which describes to the Environment Protection Authority (EPA) the range of methods that could be used to remediate the site; and
- An application to the NSW Department of Planning and Environment (DPE) in order to obtain the Department's requirements for the remediation Environmental Impact Statement (EIS) which, once approved by the Minister, will allow the Stage 2 remediation to occur. The EIS will provide a comprehensive assessment of the environmental and social acceptability of any proposed remediation work.

### **Community drop-in session**

We are planning a public community drop-in session to be held later this month to provide information about the current work and upcoming remediation activities. Information sessions are informal events to provide information to you and seek feedback from you on the various parts of the project. There will be no formal presentations or speeches given so feel free to visit at any time during the session to speak to our project team.
